## Dot Sticker Letter Matching

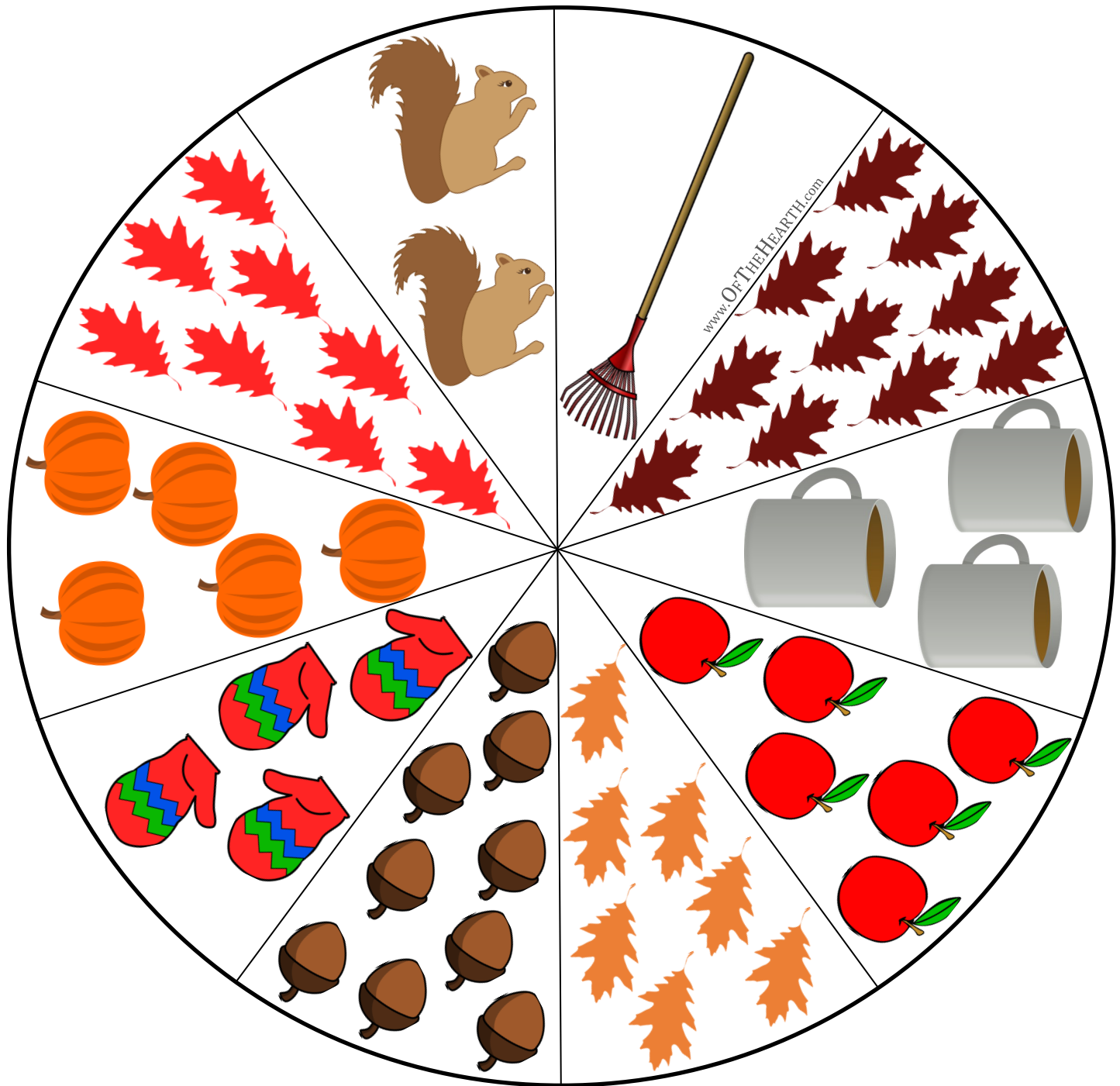
*Supplies: This paper, 3/4 in. diameter round labels that are orange (such as Avery 5474), and a pen.*

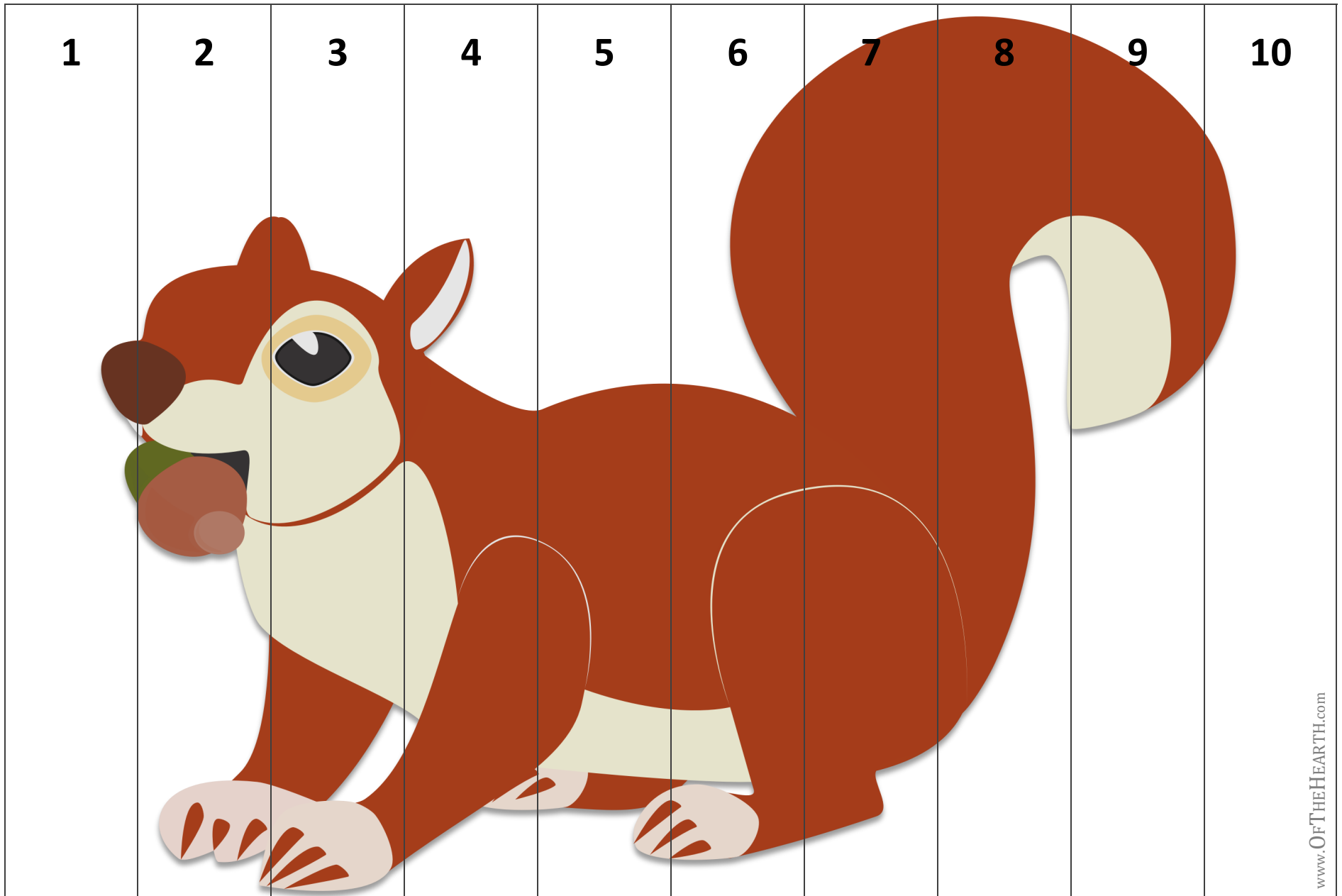
## Clothespin Number Match

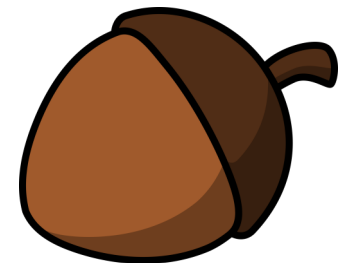
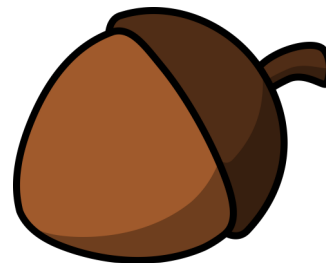
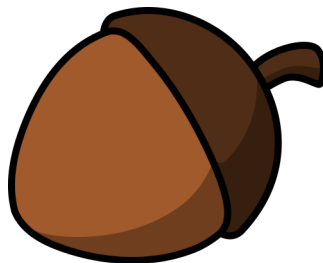
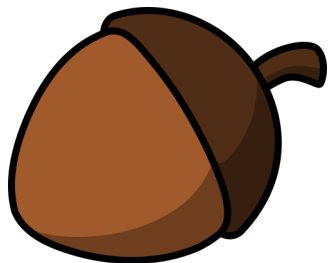
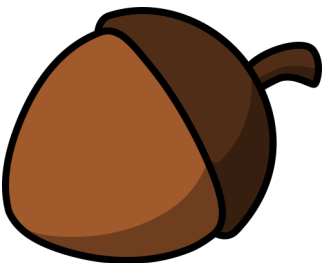
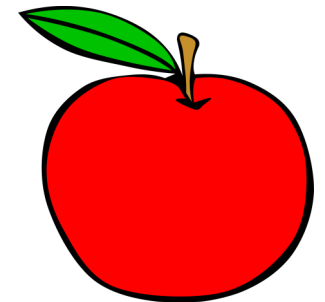
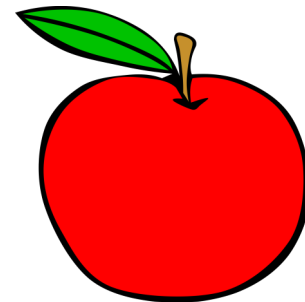
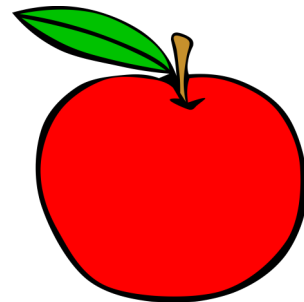
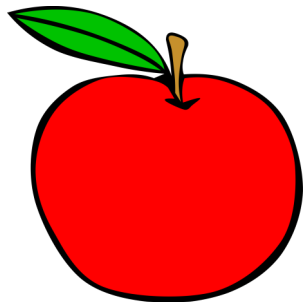
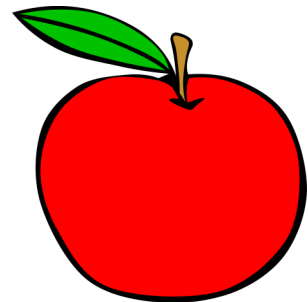
# Number Order Puzzle
